## ValueOptions® Maryland Update November 12, 2009

<u>Medical Necessity Criteria</u>: The updated "Medical Necessity Criteria for Use by Maryland PMHS" has been approved by the MHA and has been posted on the ValueOptions® website. The Criteria can be accessed and downloaded at: <u>http://maryland.valueoptions.com/provider/prv\_man.htm</u>.

## **Claims Update:**

- To ensure timely payment, please be aware that the "member number" field, on both paper and electronic claims, must include either the member's Medicaid Identification Number or the ValueOptions® Maryland assigned member number. A Social Security Number entered in the "member number" field does not allow the claim to be auto-adjudicated. These claims must be manually processed, resulting in a delay in payment.
- Reminder: Only PMHS diagnoses are reimbursable by the MHA. Providers may use ICD-9 Code 799.99 (Other unknown and unspecified cause) to request an <u>initial</u> OMS or non-OMS outpatient therapy authorization. However, this diagnosis is not reimbursable. The claim must include the diagnosis based on the evaluation of the consumer.

**Outpatient Therapy for minors in PRP:** Per MHA, the COMAR requirement that a minor receiving PRP services must also receive outpatient therapy, is met if the child is participating in individual or group therapy.
