## <u>Automated Uninsured Eligibility span for consumers whose Medicaid eligibility is</u> retroactively terminated:

Prior to December 2009, if a consumer's Medicaid eligibility was retroactively terminated, an uninsured span was generated from first day after the Medicaid eligibility termination date through the termination notification date. Example: if a consumer's Medicaid eligibility was terminated effective 8/31/09 and the termination notification date was 9/15/09, an Uninsured Eligibility span would have been generated from 9/1/09 through 9/15/09.

Effective early December 2009, if a consumer's Medicaid eligibility was retroactively terminated, an Uninsured Eligibility span would be generated from the first day after the Medicaid eligibility termination date through <u>30 days from the termination notification</u> <u>date</u>. Example: If a consumer's Medicaid eligibility was terminated effective 8/31/09 and the termination notification date was 9/15/09, an Uninsured Eligibility span would be generated from 9/1/09 through 10/15/09. Currently, this is a manual process.

Effective 12/18/09 this process will be automated.

When the process is automated, an Uninsured Eligibility span will also be automatically generated for a Medicaid termination date that is <u>not</u> retroactive, but is within 30 days of the notification date. That, is an Uninsured Eligibility span will be generated for 30 days from the termination date. Example: If notification of Termination is received on 1/1/10 that Medicaid Eligibility will terminate on 1/15/10, an Uninsured Eligibility span will generated from 1/15/10 through 2/15/10.
