ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE UPDATE FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH INPATIENT FACILITY PROVIDERS

AUGUST 20, 2018

In addition to phase 1 and 1.1 providers, phase 2.1 providers should now utilize the Electronic Provider Revalidation and Enrollment Portal (ePREP). ePREP is the one-stop shop for provider enrollment, re-enrollment, revalidation, information updates, and demographic changes. ePREP can be accessed at the following website https://eprep.health.maryland.gov/sso/login.do .
