

PROVIDER ALERT

RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTERS (PT 88) Revised DES 1000 Form

MARCH 12, 2018

This alert is for Residential Treatment Centers (Provider Type 88) only. Effective March 9, 2018 the DES 1000 form is now called the OES 1000 form.

The new OES 1000 form specifies the following conditions in section III and the Case Manager instructions. If an individual is admitted to a Residential Treatment Center and is enrolled with an MCO upon admission, the long term care span will be open the first day of the next calendar month. If an individual is not enrolled in an MCO upon admission, the long term care span is open the day of admission. Providers will need to fill out the OES 1000 with the proper dates to ensure the long term care span is opened correctly.
